The Christening (Chrzest) Dir. M. Wrona 2009 / 86' Sun 27 Mar, 8pm

Michal invites his old friend, soldier Jacek, to be the godfather of his child. But is it possible to escape the criminal past and a mafia sentence?

Summer of 1939. 11 year old Marek is about to visit Venice, but instead is sent to a small village. Somewhere between his dreams, Venice, and the war, he must prematurely transform from a boy into a man.
